All students enrolled in a Study Abroad Program are required to pay an academic fee and a technology fee in addition to the tuition fee. If enrolled in 1-4 credit hours, the academic fee is \$27.75 (80%) and the technology fee is \$4.75 per term. If enrolled in 5 or more credit hours, the academic fee is \$55.00 (80%) and the technology fee is \$9.50 per term. Non-Virginia residents are required to pay a capital fee in addition to tuition, academic fee, and technology fee. If enrolled 1-4 credit hours, the fee is \$6.25 per term. If enrolled in 5 or more hours, the fee is \$12.50

per term.

All students receiving the Va School Personnel Tuition Rate are required to pay an academic fee and a technology fee in addition to the tuition fee. If enrolled in 1-4 credit hours, the academic fee is \$20.75 (60%) and the technology fee is \$4.75 per term. If enrolled in 5 or more credit hours, the academic fee is \$41.25 (60%) and the technology fee is \$9.50 per term. Non-Virginia residents are required to pay a capital fee in addition to tuition, academic fee and technology fee. If enrolled 1-4 credit hours, the fee is \$6.25 per term. If enrolled in 5 or more hours, the fee is \$12.50 per term. Non-Virginia Residents also must pay the out of state tuition differential.
