All students receiving the Virginia School Personnel Rate are required to pay a technology fee and library fee in addition to the tuition fee. If enrolled in 1-6 credit hours, the technology fee is \$18.50 and the library fee is \$20.00. If enrolled in 7 or more credit hours the technology fee is \$37.00 and the library fee is \$40.00. Blacksburg campus students enrolled for more than 3 credit hours per term are also required to pay comprehensive fees and students at the Northern Virginia Center enrolled for more than 3 credit hours are required to pay the Northern Virginia Student Services Fee.
