If enrolled in 5 or more credit hours, the academic fee is \$70.00 (80%) and the technology fee is \$9.50 per term. Non-Virginia residents are required to pay a capital fee in addition to tuition, the academic fee and the technology fee. If enrolled in 1-4 credit hours, the fee is \$21.25 per term. If enrolled in 5 or more credit hours the fee is \$42.50 per term.
