# Additional Comprehensive Fees For 12-week Courses

All students enrolled in a Study Abroad Program are required to pay an academic fee and technology fee in addition to the tuition fee. If enrolled in 1-4 credit hours, the academic fee is \$52.50 (80%) and the technology fee is \$42.75 per term. If enrolled in 5 or more credit hours, the academic fee is \$105.00 (80%) and the technology fee is \$9.50 per term. Non-Virginia residents are required to pay a capital fee in addition to tuition, the academic fee and the technology fee. If enrolled in 1-4 credit hours, the fee is \$21.25 per term. If enrolled in 5 or more credit hours the fee is \$42.50 per term.

All students receiving the VA School Personnel tuition rate are required to pay an academic fee and a technology fee. Non-Virginia residents are also required to pay a capital fee. If enrolled in 1-3 credit hours, the student will pay \$39.25 (60%) academic fee and \$4.75 technology fee in addition to tuition. If enrolled in 4 or more credit hours, the student will pay all comprehensive fee associated with the courses, the technology fee, the capital fee (if applies), and 60% of the academic fee in addition to tuition.

#### Masters of Information Technology (MIT):
