Tuition and Fees for Summer Sessions, 2010

Per Six-week Session

Notice to students enrolled on or after August 1, 2006

In compliance with Virginia state law, students classified as in-state undergraduate students who enroll at a state educational institution August 1, 2006 or later will be assessed a tuition surcharge for each semester **after 125% of the degree requirements for their program has been completed.** The amount of the **surcharge**, established by the State Council for Higher Education in Virginia, is equal to 100% of the Average Cost of Education for the institution less tuition and mandatory Educational and General fees for in state undergraduates. Please refer to **the Office of the University Registrar** for additional information and exemptions to the surcharge.

Additional Comprehensive Fees For 12-week Courses

Students enrolled in a 12-Week session will be assessed the same tuition rates as above, but will have additional fees assessed after the last day to add for the second Summer Semester. The total amount of the fees assessed will be contingent upon the number of hours for the 12-Week session and the number of hours registered for the second summer session not to exceed the amount of full time hours.

Students enrolled in a 12-week session only and not registered for additional hours will be assessed the same tuition rates as above and the following fees:

All students enrolled in a Study Abroad Program are required to pay an academic fee and technology fee in addition to the tuition fee. If enrolled in 1-4 credit hours, the academic fee is \$56.25 (80%) and the technology fee is \$5.00 per term. If enrolled in 5 or more credit hours, the academic fee is \$112.25 (80%) and the technology fee is \$10.00 per term. Non-Virginia residents are required to pay a capital fee in addition to tuition, the academic fee and the technology fee. If enrolled in 1-4 credit hours, the fee is \$48.75 per term. If enrolled in 5 or more credit hours the fee is \$97.50 per term.

All students receiving the VA School Personnel tuition rate are required to pay an academic fee and a technology fee. Non-Virginia residents are also required to pay a capital fee. If enrolled in 1-3 credit hours, the student will pay \$42.00 (60%) academic fee and \$5.00 technology fee in addition to tuition. If enrolled in 4 or more credit hours, the student will pay all comprehensive fee associated with the courses, the technology fee, the capital fee (if applies), and 60% of the academic fee in addition to tuition.

If enrolled in 5 or more credit hours, the technology fee is \$10.00 per semester and the academic fee is \$140.25 per semester. Non-VA residents are required to pay the Capital and Equipment Fee (48.75 for 1-4 hours or \$97.50 for 5 or more credit hours).
