

# Tuition and Fees for Winter Session 2018

Winter Session enrollments will be billed on November 15, 2017, and will be due on December 11, 2017. Undergraduate Tuition is charged per credit hour. There is no minimum nor maximum credit hour assessment. Graduate and Extended Campus Tuition is charged at tiers: 1-3 credit hours, 4 credit hours, and 5 or more credit hours. Executive PhD program Tuition is charged per credit hour with a minimum 3 credit hours assessment and a maximum 9 credit hours assessment.

Comprehensive Fees are charged based on the number of credit hours enrolled. All Winter Session Tuition, Comprehensive Fees, Special Fees and Course Fees are subject to the university's existing [refund policies and procedures](#). Students should review their account upon adding or dropping courses.

## Payment Deadline

Winter Session 2018: December 11, 2017

### Notice to students enrolled on or after August 1, 2006:

In compliance with Virginia state law, students classified as in-state undergraduate students who enroll at a state educational institution August 1, 2006 or later will be assessed a tuition surcharge for each semester **after 125% of the degree requirements for their program has been completed**. The amount of the **surcharge**, established by the State Council for Higher Education in Virginia, is equal to 100% of the Average Cost of Education for the institution less tuition and mandatory Educational and General Fees for in state undergraduates.
