

Tuition and Fees for Summer Semester, 2020

Billing Dates and Payment Deadlines

Summer semester will be billed on May 18, 2020 and will be due June 10, 2020

Undergraduate Tuition is charged per credit hour with no minimum nor maximum credit hour assessment.
Graduate and Extended Campus Tuition is charged per credit hour with a minimum 3 credit hours assessment and a maximum 9 credit hours assessment.
Executive PhD program Tuition is charged per credit hour with no minimum nor maximum credit hour assessment.

Comprehensive Fees are charged based on the number of credit hours enrolled for the entire summer semester.

In compliance with Virginia state law, students classified as in-state undergraduate students who enroll at a state educational institution August 1, 2006 or later will be assessed a tuition surcharge for each semester after 125% of the degree requirements for their program has been completed. The amount of the surcharge for academic year 19-20 is \$360 per credit hour. Established by the State Council for Higher Education in Virginia, it is equal to 100% of the Average Cost of Education for the institution less tuition and mandatory Educational and General Fees for in state undergraduates. Please refer to the Office of the University Registrar for additional information and exemptions to the surcharge

Immigration Services Fee: The Immigration Services Fee is not assessed for the summer semester.

The Virginia School Personnel rate is a reduced tuition rate for school personnel employed full-time in grades K-12 in Virginia Schools.

The reduced tuition rate is applicable only to the in-state portion of tuition. For example, Virginia School Personnel who reside outside of Virginia would receive the reduced tuition rate on the in-state portion of the tuition and the student would be responsible for the full amount of the additional out-of-state tuition charge.
