Billing Dates and Payment Deadlines

Fall Semester will be billed on July 18, 2022 and will be due August 10, 2022 Spring Semester will be billed on December 19, 2022 and will be due January 10, 2023

In compliance with Virginia state law, students classified as in-state undergraduate students who enroll at a state educational institution August 1, 2006 or later will be assessed a tuition surcharge for each semeste**after 125% of the degree requirements for their program has been completed**. The amount of the surcharge for academic year 22-23 is \$375.75 per credit hour. Established by the State Council for Higher Education in Virginia, it is equal to 100% of the Average Cost of Education for the institution less tuition and mandatory Educational and General Fees for in state undergraduates. Please refer to the **Office of the University Registrar** for additional information and exemptions to the surcharge.

All Tuition and Fees are subject to the university's existing refund policies and procedures. Students should review their account upon adding or dropping courses.

Students in an all virtual schedule (or research/independent study conducted off-campus) and who will reside more than 50 miles from the Blacksburg campus during the semester may apply to have their comprehensive fees reduced by \$300 for full-time students (7 or more credit hours) or by \$150 for part-time (1-6 credit hours). The Living Learning Community fee is \$50 per semester and is charged to residents in the living learning community areas of Harper (Mozaiko), Hillcrest (Hillcrest Honors), Hoge (Galileo and Hypatia), New Hall West (Aurora), New Residence Hall East (Orion), Newman (Transfer Experience), Payne (Meraki), Pritchard (GenerationOne, Impact, Thrive, and VIA Communities), and Peddrew-Yates (Ujima). A residential college comprises the whole of the building in which it is housed. All students who live in a residential college building have access to the programming and staffing, and therefore are required to pay the LLC fee, whether or not they applied to be part of the residential college program. Residential colleges are housed in Ambler Johnston (Honors Residential Commons at East AJ and Residential College at West AJ), Creativity and Innovation District (Innovate, Rhizome, and Studio 72), and O'Shaughnessy (Leadership and Social Change Residential College).
