In compliance with Virginia state law, students classified as in-state undergraduate students who enroll at a state educational institution August 1, 2006 or later will be assessed a tuition surcharge for each semester after 125% of the degree requirements for their program has been completed. The amount of the surcharge for academic year 23-24 is \$273.00 per credit hour. Established by the State Council for Higher Education in Virginia, it is equal to 100% of the Average Cost of Education for the institution less tuition and mandatory Educational and General Fees for in state undergraduates. Please refer to the Office of the University Registrar for additional information and exemptions to the surcharge.

All Tuition and Fees are subject to the university's existing refund policies and procedures. Students should review their account upon adding or dropping courses.

Students in an all virtual schedule (or research/independent study conducted off-campus) and who will reside more than 50 miles from the Blacksburg campus during the semester may apply to have their comprehensive fees reduced by \$300 for full-time students (7 or more credit hours) or by \$150 for part-time (1-6 credit hours). Applications can be found at busar.vt.edu and must be completed by the last day to add each semester.

Pending final action by the General Assembly, the board authorizes the president to reduce increases to the comprehensive fee and room and board to 6.9% and 8.9% respectively. The rates posed in this chart reflect no reduction at this time.

Status is conferred after application each semester and certification by the Graduate School for a maximum of 4 semesters for full-time students enrolled in research and dissertation hours only. All students receiving the discount are required to pay a technology fee of \$42.00 and library fee of \$55.00 in addition to tuition. Non-VA residents are also required to pay the Commonwealth Facility and Equipment Fee. Blacksburg campus students enrolled are also required to pay comprehensive fees. Students at the Falls Church campus will be required to pay the NOVA Student Services Fee of \$91.50, and the Northern Virginia Transporation fee of 164.00 for full-time students.

Virginia School Personnel
