In compliance with Virginia state law, students classified as in-state undergraduate students who enroll at a state educational institution August 1, 2006 or later will be assessed a tuition surcharge for each semester after 125% of the degree requirements for their program has been completed. The amount of the surcharge for academic year 24-25 is \$299.50 per credit hour. Established by the State Council for Higher Education in Virginia, it is equal to 100% of the Average Cost of Education for the institution less tuition and mandatory Educational and General Fees for in state undergraduates. Please refer to the Office of the University Registrar for additional information and exemptions to the surcharge.

All Tuition and Fees are subject to the university's existing refund policies and procedures. Students should review their account upon adding or dropping courses.

Students in an all virtual schedule (or research/independent study conducted off-campus) and who will reside more than 50 miles from the Blacksburg campus during the semester may apply to have their comprehensive fees reduced by \$671.00 for full-time students (7 or more credit hours) or by \$335.50 for part-time (1-6 credit hours).
